NEW COMPETITION ENTRY DETAILS

During a recent meeting between Management and representative members of the Competition Committee it was agreed that the running of Handicap Qualifying Competitions would commence as from the 1st July and be run in accordance with the Safety Guidelines as laid down by England Golf.

Members are asked to book their entry times either by phone or in person, with Laurie or Tom in the pro-shop. Please do not visit the club just to sign up for a competition.

Members will be notified by email of their confirmed tee times in advance of the competition start date, as usual.

Payment of the competition entry fee should be made in cash in the pro-shop when signing in on the day of the competition. Please make every effort to bring the correct change and please sign in with you own pen/pencil. Please collect a blank scorecard from the Pro-shop.

In order that you do not have to swap cards, do not enter your details on the card. Instead please fill in the card for the player for whom you are the agreed marker.

Please write clearly the following: -

- Date
- Competition Name
- Name of Player whose card you are marking (Player A)
- Player A's Handicap
- Sign and print your name at bottom of scorecard DO NOT SWAP CARDS

Members are asked to ensure that the correct Gross Score for each hole is entered in Column A, for the named player on the card, and that their own gross score is entered in the Markers Score column.

At the completion of the round again DO NOT SWAP CARDS. The players should confer verbally to agree gross scores for each hole before the marker only signs the scorecard.

Scorecards should be retained by the marker and a copy of the card should either be scanned and emailed to mpgc.uk@gmail.com or photographed and sent by text to John Bennett on 07984 653649 so that the scores can be entered in to the Handicap Master software. Competition results, together with current handicaps, will as normal be displayed on Master Scoreboard.

Members are reminded that they should keep two metres apart at teeing areas, when walking to the ball, searching for a ball, playing shots on the putting green. Players are required to leave the flagstick in the hole at all times and not to touch it.

No rakes are allowed on the course, members are asked to make their very best efforts to smooth the sand using their club and/or their feet and if members take due care when smoothing bunkers, there should be no need to provide a Local Rule for bunkers.

Social distancing is as important after a round as it is during the round, so when the round is over all golfers are encouraged to leave the course and the club/facility immediately so that there are no gatherings around the clubhouse area.

HANDICAP & SUPPLEMENTARY SCORECARDS

With the reintroduction of Qualifying Competitions as from the 1st July, members will be able to obtain a handicap by submitting any combination of 18-hole or 9-hole scorecards for a handicap to be allocated, so long as the total number of holes played is 54.

In addition members with CONGU Handicaps in Categories 2 to 6 may submit an unlimited number of supplementary scores per year with no restrictions on the number of cards that can be submitted per week. Special restrictions remain in place for Category 1 players.

Players may submit 9-hole or 18-hole Supplementary cards at any course in GB & NI at which they are a member.

New Instructions:

Members wishing to submit cards for handicap and supplementary purposes should register their intentions to do so with Laurie or Tom in the pro-shop before playing their round. Their name and details, which would normally have been completed by the member, will then be entered for them on to the appropriate form,

The marker/playing partner for the round should obtain a scorecard.

In order that you do not have to swap cards, do not enter your details on the card. Instead please fill in the card for the player for whom you are the agreed marker.

Please write clearly the following: -

- Date
- Competition Name (Supplementary or Handicap)
- Name of Player whose card you are marking (Player A)
- Player A's Handicap
- Sign and print your name at bottom of scorecard DO NOT SWAP CARDS.
